


Peerceptiv Spring 2017 User Interface Upgrade





5. Many settings have moved from the course level to the assignment level, including Reviewing Style and Grading settings. Also, Peerceptiv has introduced a new course setting, Allow Review without Upload. This setting determines whether students can review peer documents without submitting their own document. The default selection prevents reviews without upload.
